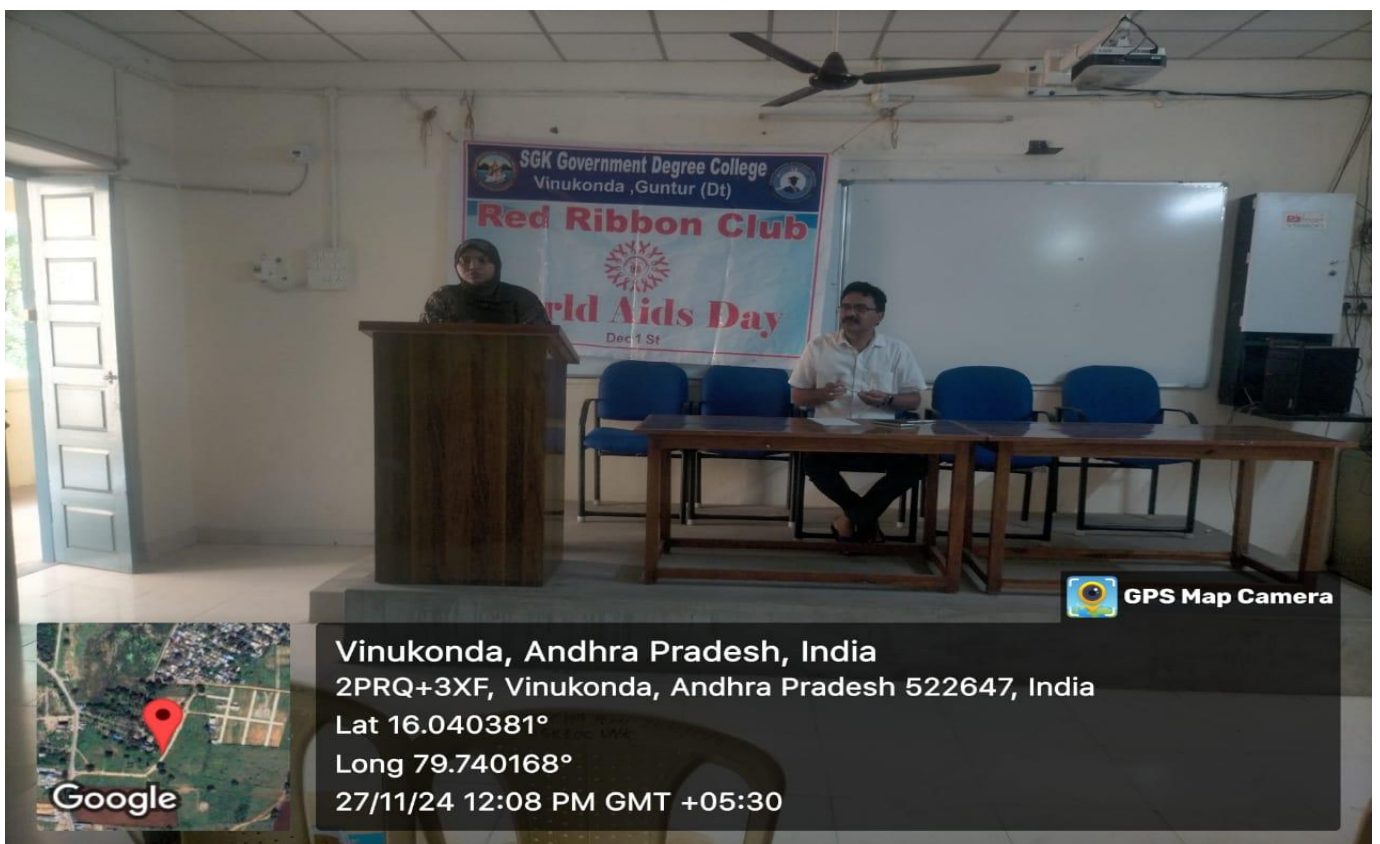
The debate was effective in spreading awareness about HIV/AIDS and inspiring students to take a proactive role in prevention efforts
