Brief Description:

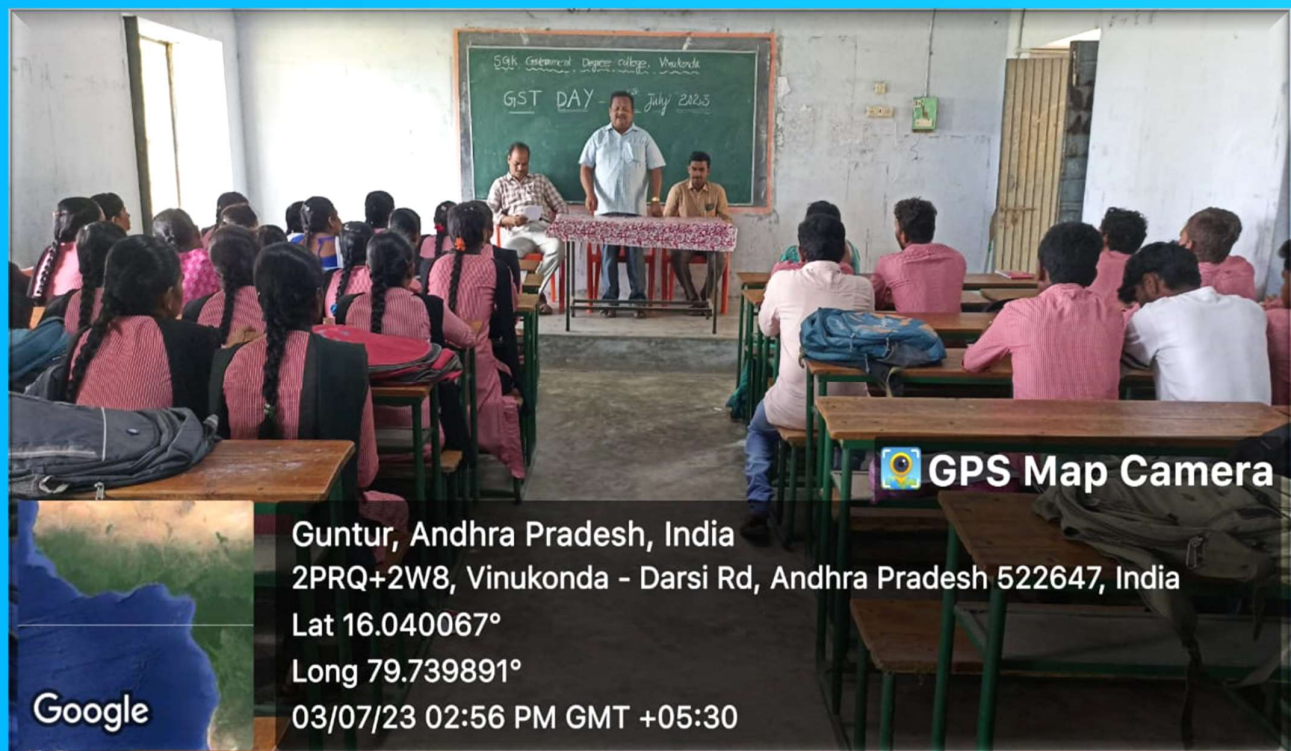

Principal Dr. K. Sreenivasa Rao Garu addressed the gathering at GST Day 2023 celebrated at seminar hall. The idea of a Goods and Services Tax (GST) in India was first proposed in the early 2000s, with the formation of the Kelkar Task Force on indirect taxes in 2003. The introduction of GST marked a significant milestone in the country’s economic reforms. It aimed to streamline the taxation system, promote ease of doing business, eliminate tax cascading, and create a unified market for goods and services across India.

Vice principal Ch Hari Babu sir expressed his views on GST Day 2023 is celebrated to acknowledge the hard work and dedication of the officials who were involved in the implementation of the GST regime. GST has replaced multiple indirect taxes charged by the central and state governments, including excise duty, service tax, value-added tax (VAT), and others, making the tax system more straight forward and transparent. The implementation of GST has also reduced compliance costs for taxpayers, promoting ease of doing business and improving the country's overall business climate.

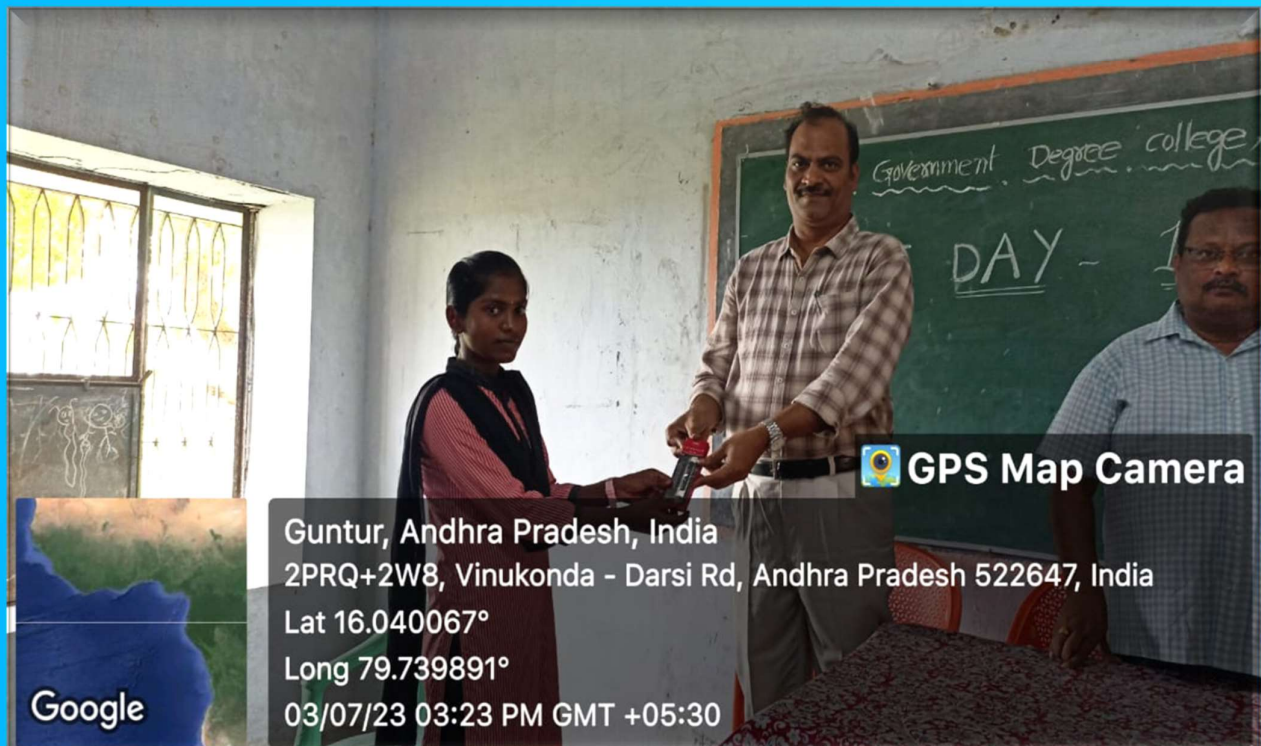
