An In-house Training Programme on **First Aid and Disaster Management** was organized on 24-07-2025 at the **Seminar Hall of SGK Government Degree College, Vinukonda**. The programme was jointly organized by the **Red Ribbon Club (RRC)** and the **Department of Zoology** with the aim of equipping student volunteers with essential knowledge and practical skills to respond effectively during emergencies and disaster situations.

Programme Objectives

- To create awareness among students about the importance of **First Aid and Disaster Management**.
- To train Red Cross volunteers in **basic life-saving techniques and emergency response**.
- To develop **confidence and preparedness** among students to handle emergency situations effectively.
- To encourage **social responsibility and volunteer service** among youth.

The programme was inaugurated in the presence of **Principal Dr. K. Srinivasa Rao garu, IQAC Coordinator Dr. K. V. S. Koteswara Rao garu, NSS Coordinator Sri D. Siva Phanindra garu, and Sri B. R. K. Kishore garu, RRC Coordinator and Head of the Department of Zoology**. Addressing the gathering, the Principal emphasized the importance of first aid knowledge and

disaster preparedness among students, stating that timely assistance during emergencies can save lives and reduce the severity of injuries.

Dr. K. V. S. Koteswara Rao garu, IQAC Coordinator, highlighted the need for youth participation in community service and encouraged students to develop skills that contribute to public safety and social responsibility.

Sri D. Siva Phanindra garu, NSS Coordinator, explained the role of volunteers during disasters such as floods, earthquakes, and accidents, and advised students to remain calm, alert, and ready to help society in times of crisis.

Sri B. R. K. Kishore garu, RRC Coordinator and Head of the Department of Zoology, provided valuable insights on the basic principles of first aid, including handling minor injuries, controlling bleeding, assisting unconscious persons, and responding to emergency situations. He also explained the importance of disaster management strategies such as preparedness, response, recovery, and mitigation.

Students and Red Cross volunteers actively participated in the training programme and gained practical awareness about safety measures, emergency response techniques, and community support during disasters.

As part of the programme, a **Slogan Writing Competition** was conducted for students on the theme of **First Aid and Disaster Management Awareness**. Students participated enthusiastically and presented creative slogans highlighting the importance of safety, preparedness, and humanitarian service. The winners of the competition were appreciated and awarded prizes by the organizers.

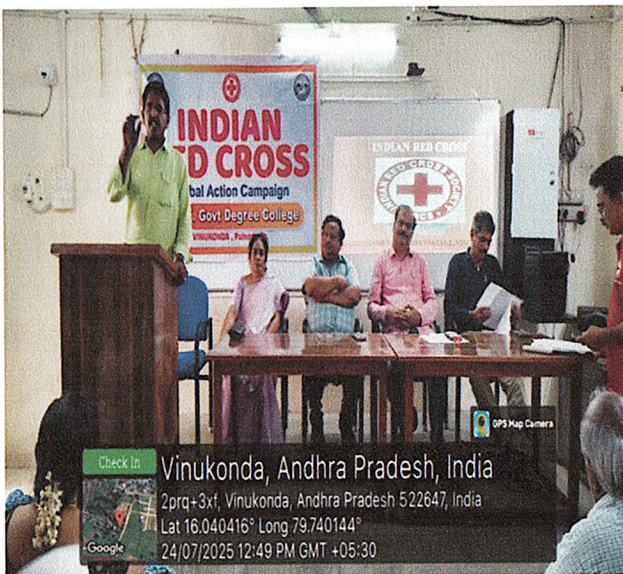
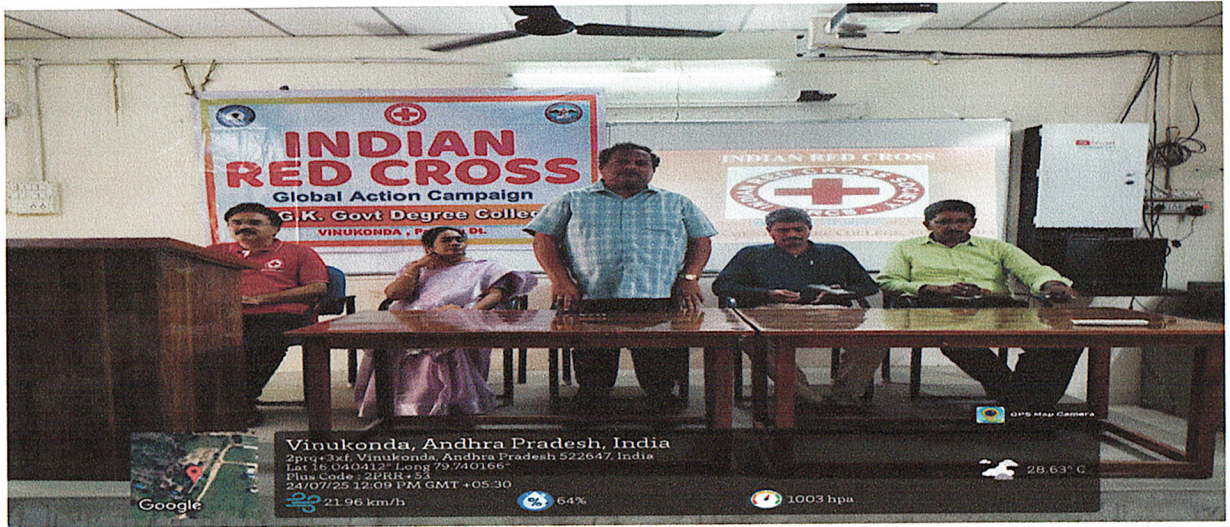
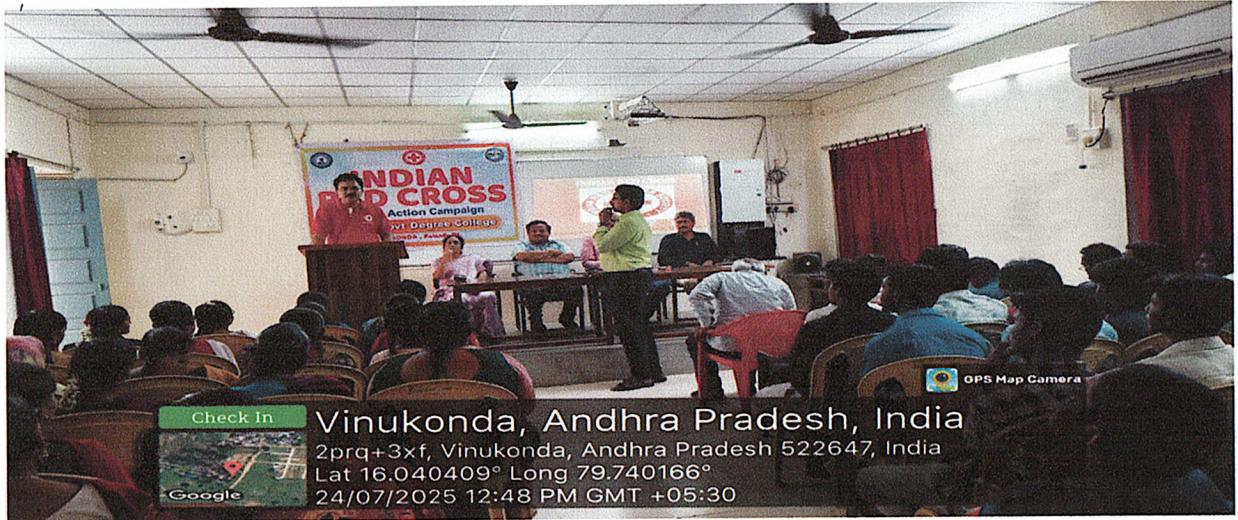
