To create awareness among students and the public about the harmful effects of drug abuse and illegal drug trafficking, a two-day programme was organized on **25 and 26 June 2025** at SGK Government Degree College, Vinukonda. The programme was conducted by the **College Health Center** in collaboration with the **Departments of Chemistry, Zoology, Botany, and NSS** as part of the observance of **International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking**.

Programme Objectives

1. To create awareness among students and the public about the harmful effects of drug abuse and illicit drug trafficking.
2. To educate youth about the health, social, and legal consequences of drug addiction.
3. To encourage students to develop a responsible attitude towards building a drug-free society.
4. To involve students in awareness activities such as essay writing competitions and rallies to spread the message against drug abuse.
5. To strengthen cooperation between educational institutions, police authorities, and the community in preventing drug abuse.

Day – 1: 25 June 2025

On the occasion of International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking, a two-day awareness programme was organized at SGK Government Degree College, Vinukonda on 25 and 26 June 2025 by the College Health Center in collaboration with the Departments of Chemistry, Zoology, Botany and NSS.

On the first day, 25 June 2025, the programme was conducted in the college to create awareness among students about the harmful effects of drug abuse and illicit trafficking. The programme was attended by the Principal, **Dr. K. Srinivasa Rao garu**, and the IQAC Coordinator, **Dr. K.V.S. Koteswara Rao garu**. The chief guest for the programme was **Smt. Udayalakshmi garu, Sub-Inspector of Police, Vinukonda Police Station**.

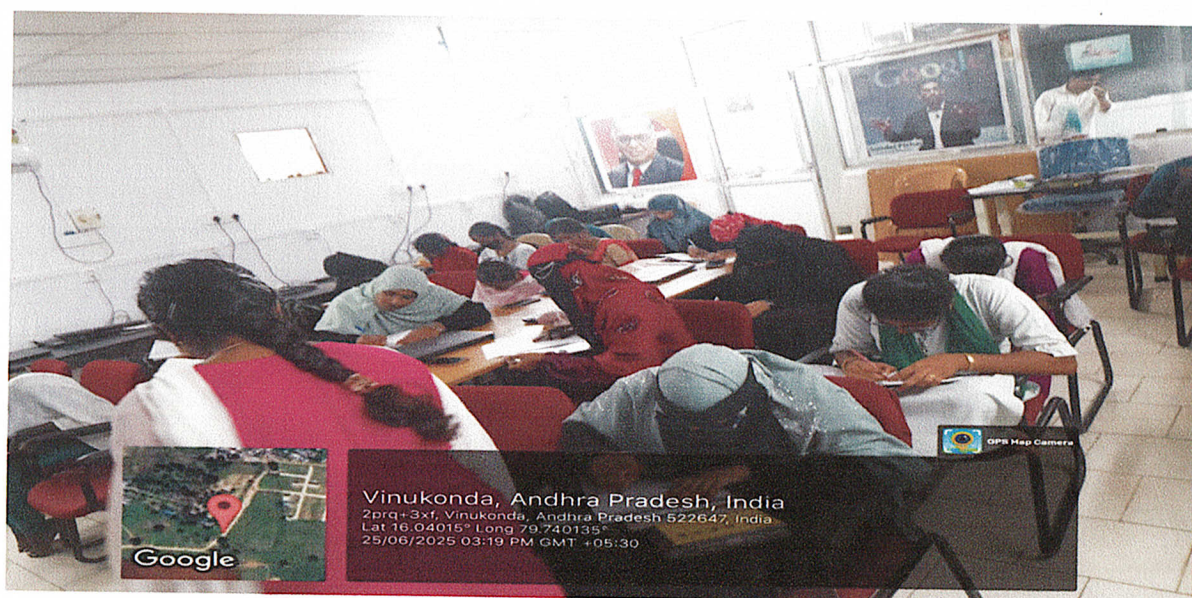
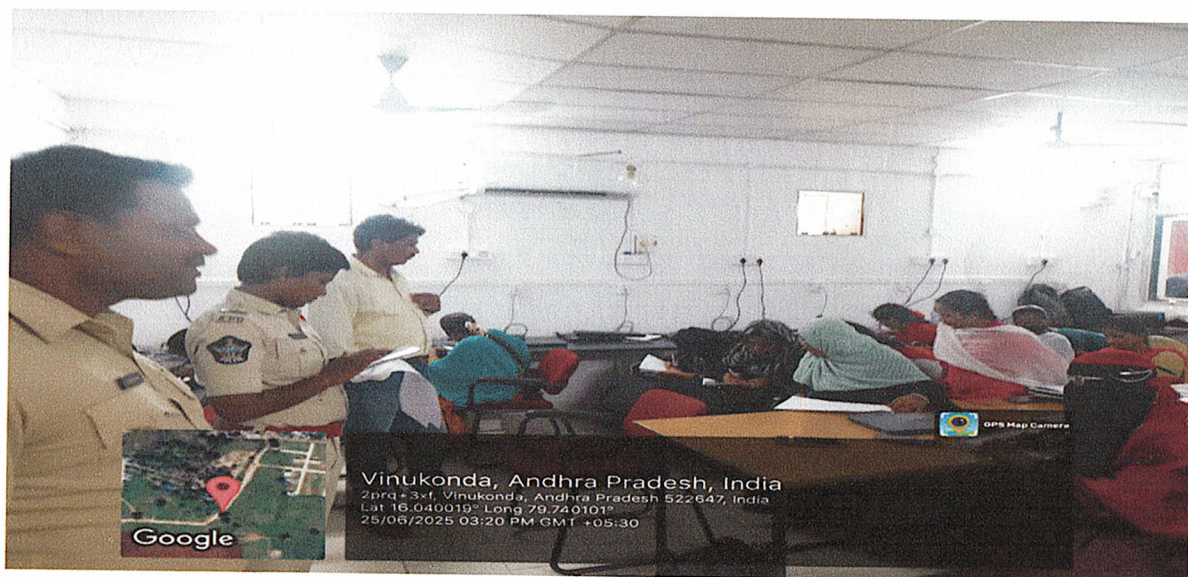

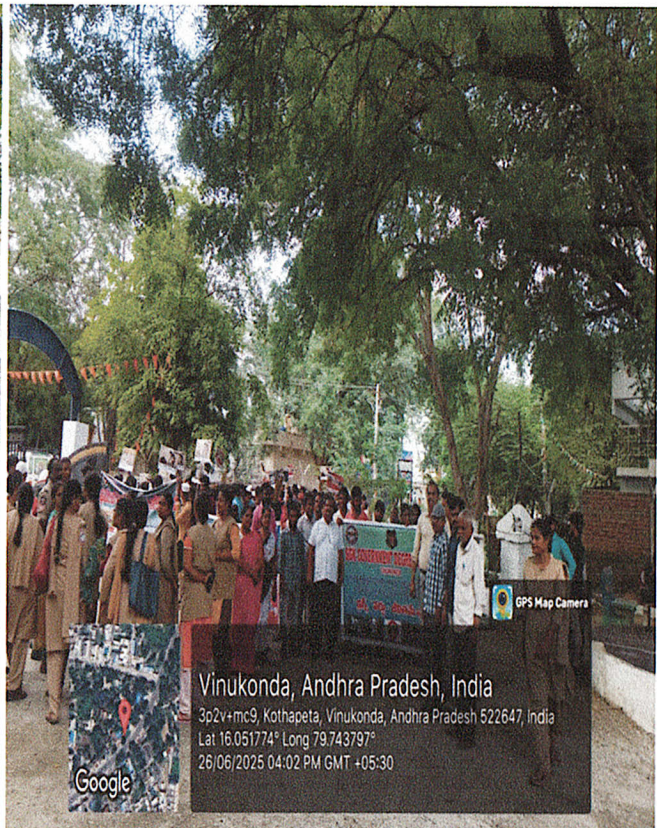
