

#### SOCIO ECONOMIC SURVEY

Introduction: As part of the project work we conducted Socio-Economic Survey of village Mathukumalli in Savalyapuram Mandal in Palnadu district of Andhra Pradesh, we have the opportunity to closely observe the various forms of economic issues that is pulling down its development of the village and understand its impact on the lives of the people of the village.

#### **OBJECTIVES:**

The main objective of the Socio-Economic Survey is:

- 1. To get insight into Socio-Economic condition of rural life
- 2. To understand the dynamics of various village level conditions in addressing the developmental work.
- 3. To understand the status of villagers, their contribution and the role played by them in developing the country.
- 4. To understand the dynamics of social structure infrastructure resources and various interventions and the villagers and how it effects them ·
- 5. To blend classroom learning with the project work experience.

Methodology: The data collected is on demography, social structure, infrastructure facilities, village economy both quantitative and qualitative data were taken the quantitative data was on population, land holding, literacy rate. The qualitative data was quality of the road, housing pattern, sanitation which was obtained from the house hold survey.

- 1. Sources of data: The primary data was collected from direct interaction with the villages during house hold survey (through questionnaire given by the college).
- 2. Sample design for questionnaire survey systematic random sampling was done. 50 households were selected randomly efforts were made to collect different information regarding socio economic status of the villagers from all castes and economic group.
- 3. Data analysis, Statistical tools like tables, graphs, bar charts, averages percentages etc...were used to analyze the data collected on various things like castes, assets, land holdings and different infrastructure like roads.
- 4. Limitations of data collection

People hesitate to tell about the details regarding income and assets.

- a. Most of the villagers are daily wagers therefore they are available only in the evening
- b. People are not clear about the present value of their asset.
- 5. Geography and social structure Mathukumalli is a small village located 8 Kilometers away from Mandal headquarter Savalyapuram of palnadu district in the state of Andhra Pradesh. It is located 60 kms away from Narsaraopet. It is a hamlet with 260 houses with 1000 people. The major advantage to this village is just adjacent to Guntur, Guntur national highway except that it is backward in all aspects with poor people, little land holdings. Most of the villagers are daily wage earners eking their living by doing masonry work in nearby small town Vinukonda.

- 5.4 Literacy level of the village is 100% on par with men, women also got educated but not up to graduation
- 5.5 Social structure of the village is homogenous population of Hindu. The social group composition of the village Mathukumalli is divided amongst schedule castes, backward castes and other castes hierarchy based class structure is visible. 50% of the 50 household survey revealed other castes and 50% comprised scheduled and backward castes.
- 6. Primary and secondary occupation of the village. From the household survey observed that majority of them are engaged in agriculture as primary occupation and the rest are engaged in non-agriculture labor, farm cultivator services, agriculture laborer, home maker etc... as secondary occupation. Majority of the earning members are men and women are working as farm laborers.
  - 6.2. Land holding pattern: The land holding pattern of Mathukumalli is very complex. Majority of households have 2 to 3 acres each. They use the land in proper manner for cultivation because the land is limited. Those who do not have land depend on daily wages.
  - 6.3. Service holders: There are service holders in the village of which 2 are involved in private service. There are just 3 graduates in the 50 households surveyed
- 7. Government Schemes: Villagers utilize Govt. Welfare schemes to a larger extent majority of the householders utilize government schemes. i.e. they have ration eards and make use of public distribution system and every month they receive rice, dal and sugar from the government, with subsidized price
- 8. Self help groups: Majority of the women are members in village self help groups. They contribute some amount monthly to the DWACRA [Development of women and children in rural areas] group and the needy women utilize the amount as loan for their sustainability. Government sometimes help them by giving freebies.
