The programme created awareness about preventive healthcare and emphasized the importance of maintaining personal hygiene and healthy living habits.

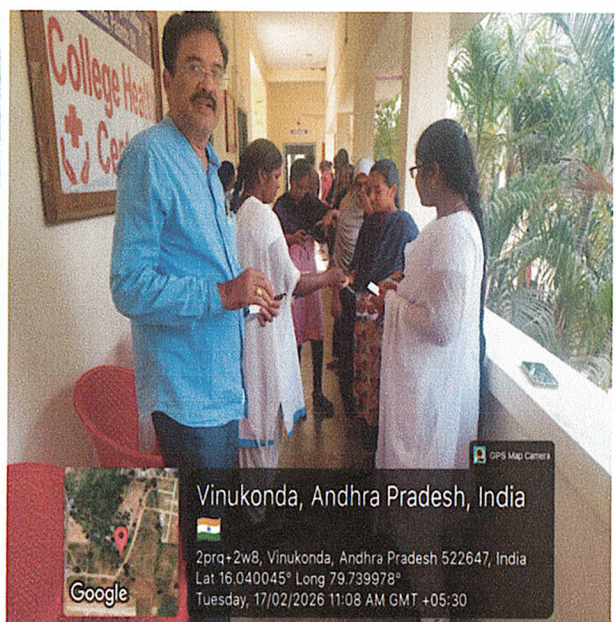
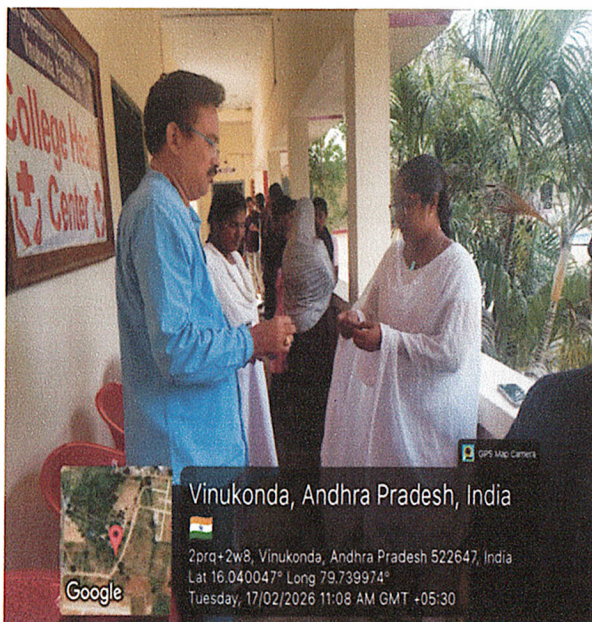
Programme Outcomes
