Volleyball Tournament for Boys

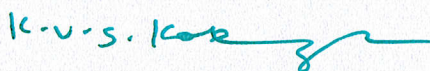

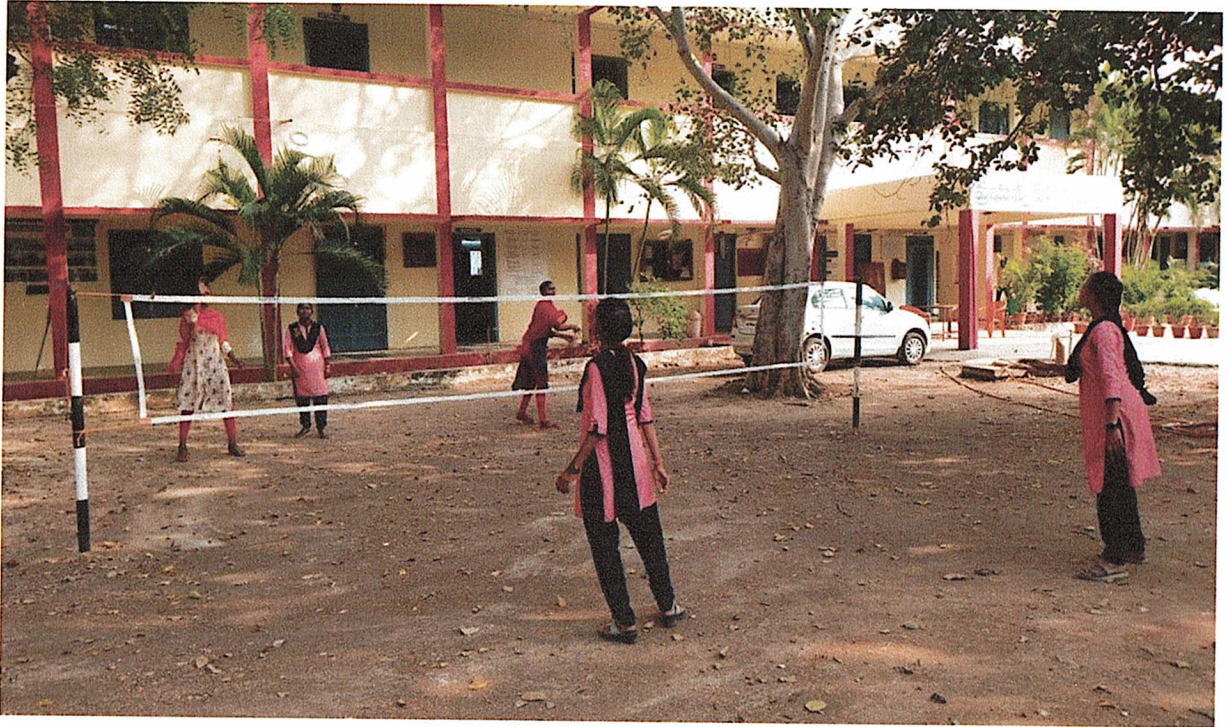
