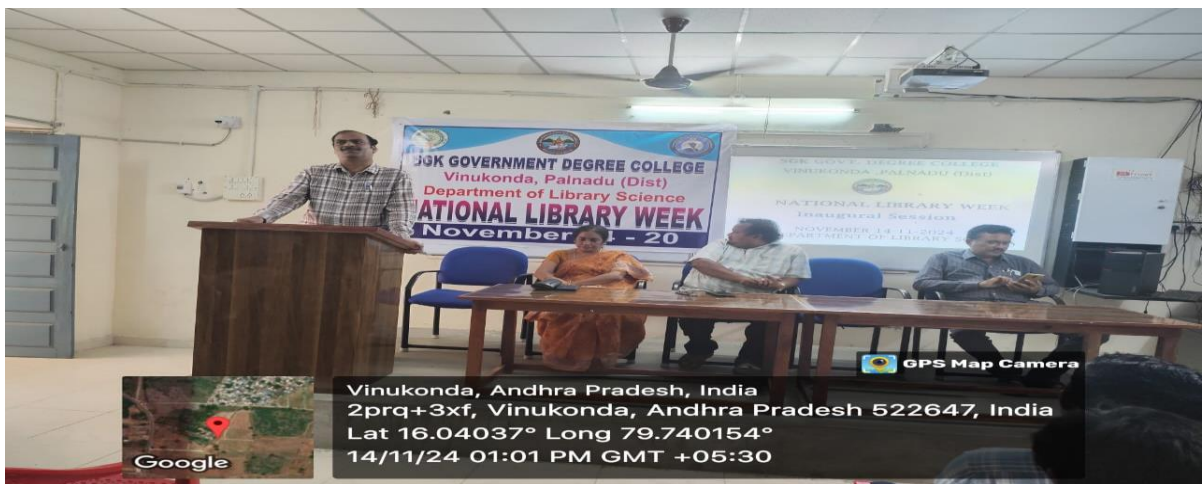
#### **Conclusion:**
