The campus cleaning activity developed teamwork and leadership qualities among students. The programme also created a sense of social responsibility among the participants.


The college campus became clean and litter-free after the programme. The programme created awareness and motivated students to maintain cleanliness regularly.

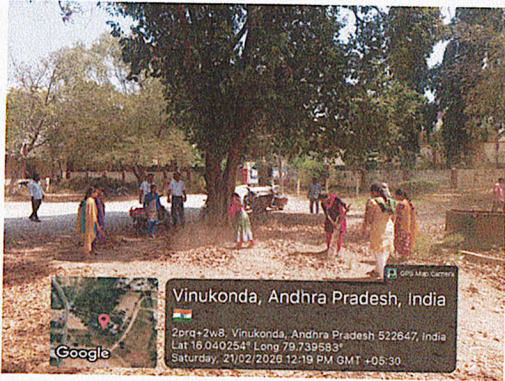

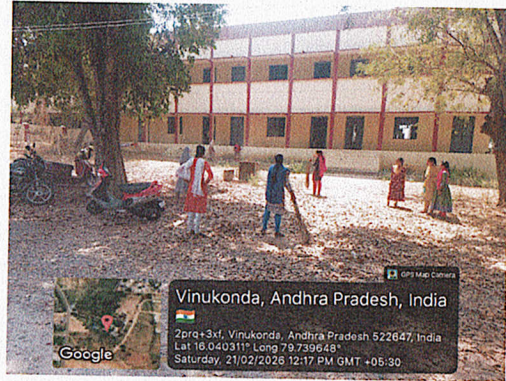

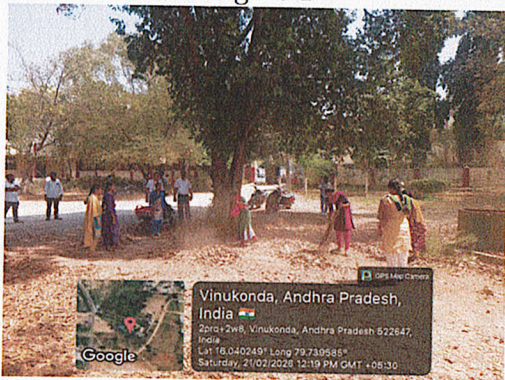

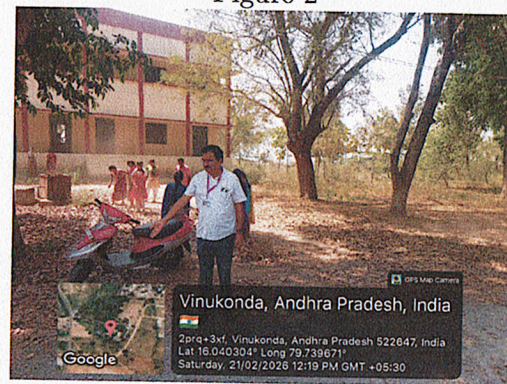

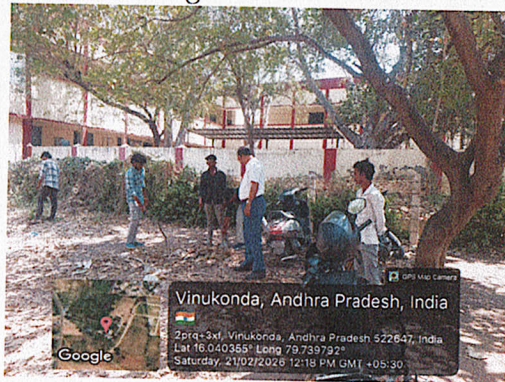
